NO SUCH WORD restrained in the early going off the rail, waited between foes turning for home, angled out four wide, hit a seen, responded and finished full of run to be well clear. BEAUTICIAN in the second flight along the inside while also in hand, boxed in entering the stretch, moved out, roused, finished willingly to be well clear for the place, no match for the winner. TAP TAP TAPPING brushed at the start, raced well back while saving ground, continued inside into the lane, roused, moved out late, up late for the show. DECELERATOR bumped, bobbled at the start, set the pace while along the inside, continued to show the way past the furlong marker, weakened in the late going. TIZ MIZ SUE forwardly placed while rank in the early going, tracked the pace, came up empty in the drive. BELL'S SHOES broke in, bumped foe, pressed between foes in the run into the far turn, weakened in the drive. BELLA DIAMANTE broke in, settled, in the second flight, fanned out to be four wide turning for home, lacked a late kick. DIXIE HEARTH was never involved. LAURA BABE jostled at the start, fell back to trail throughout.
