### Footnotes

FOLLOW THE LEADER unhurried in the early going, advance on the outside in the second turn, challenged turning for home, dueled past the furlong marker, drifted in a bit under a right handed whip, edged clear late. T. C. CHAMP chased the leader, moved on that one and challenged between foes and inside the winner turning for home, brushed, outkicked in the late going. SEA GAZE outrun in the early going along the inside, rated while continuing well off the pace, moved out, roused for the drive, finished up best of the rest. TOBY THE COAL MAN sprinted clear, got out to a long lead in the run up the backstretch, faltered when headed. GRESHAM settled off the pace, asked three wide late final turn, moved out to be widest in the drive, little late gain. RIMINI REBEL lacked speed, was never a threat. GARBURETOR was always outrun.
