BY DAYLIGHT allowed the speed to go early, began an outside advance early in the turn, challenged entering the stretch, slowly edged clear. LITTLE KOSTROMA lacked early foot, roused four wide exiting the turn, finished willingly to be slowly getting to the winner. HUMBLE KATHY last away, improved position by saving ground into the stretch, angled out a bit for the drive, along for the show. SHOW ME THE LIGHT forwardly placed into the first turn, vied between foes backstretch, faded. PLUMERIA well back for a half, passed tiring foes. JUICY FRUITS forwardly placed, gave way in the drive. SALTY N SASSY cleared the opening quarter, set the pace, gave way. LADY HIGH INDY flashed some early foot, stopped.
