GEORGE RAY off the pace, moved closer toward the inside into the far turn, steadied in traffic and waited midway on the second turn, got through, four wide into lane, strongly clear. NAVY WINGS void of any kind of early speed, swung out to be five wide out of the final turn, finished up willingly to be up for the place. FUFTY TOO broke alertly, forwardly placed along the inside, got through turning for home, closest to the winner in the late going, caught for that place. KENTUCKY MAN allowed to settle, asked along into the lane, angled in a bit, improved. WYNN WYNN DEAL narrowly set the pace, weakened when confronted for the drive. DOC'S FRIEND off the pace, fanned four wide into the stretch, managed little in the way of a rally. SLIGO JOE tired while five wide. STAMP pressured the pace for six furlongs, gave way in the drive.
