INDIAN BLUFF outrun in the early going, moved closer along the inside into and through the far turn, angled out turning for home, bid, going away late. COBRA KISS sprinted well clear, continued to hold a large advantage up the backstretch, responded when challenged second turn, raced on equal terms with the winner past the furlong marker, proved stubborn til late, remained well clear for the place. SANDWEE last to leave, trailed early, staged a mild rally toward the inside to earn the show. NETTIE HUGHES allowed the pace to go early, ranged up to challenge outside the leader late in the final turn, vied between into the stretch, drifted out, weakened. VEILLIT' settled off the pace and the inside, moved closer three wide into the far turn, fell back soon after, evenly to the wire. BEER N CRICKETS lacked speed, was never a threat. CATHYWITHAC closest to the leader for five furlongs, stopped far turn.
