MINWORKS narrowly set the pace along the inside, continued to vie into the far turn, larger lead soon after, shook clear into the lane, increased advantage under steady handling. STORM ON THE LOOSE vied early, fell back off the leaders onto the backstretch, asked along in the second turn, set down four wide into the stretch, in time for the place. DEVIL HIMSELF vied up front off the inside, between rivals in the second turn, proved no match for the winner, closest to that foe late, nipped final strides for the place. CHASENTEGOLD outrun in the early going, advanced toward inside midway on the second turn, swung 4w, mild rally. ECONOMIC RECOVERY was never a threat toward the inside. JONES DESTINY five wide into the first turn, brushed, continued to prompt the pace second turn, weakened. ZANETTI with the first flight while four wide and between foes into the first turn, roughed, fell back, failed to rally. PAWPAW'S PLEASURE trailed throughout in showing little.
