INERTIA outrun in the early going, saved some ground, closer in some traffic second turn, split foes, inherited the advantage late when the leader ducked out, all out final strides. ALI'S KNOCKOUT broke out, straightened to move up and press the issue early, chased leader in the run up the backstretch, bid, took over into the lane, got clear, ducked out just inside the furlong marker, lost the advantage, outkicked late. BUBBA PRINCESS off the early pace, made a move into contention with a five wide move in the second turn, lost some ground to the top two into the lane, angled in, between foes at the wire, not enough. SARAH'S SPLENDOR in tight at the start, got out a bit into the first turn when racing forwardly, continued to be within striking distance the middle half mile, tired in the drive. LITTLE MINNIE bothered at the start, fell well back, continued to trail after a half, asked late final turn, shifted out, improved position late while not a serious threat. COMPED AT THE CAL rated while narrowly showing the way into the first turn, large lead up the backstretch, faltered when headed by the runner up late in the final turn. LOOK AT PRIVATE JO five wide into the first turn, never a serious threat. CAROL'S CANDLE had little left for the drive. PAPANAZZI QUEEN four out to five wide into the first turn, bothered, steadied soon after when SARAH'S SPLENDOR got out, was finished early and was far back at the end.
