Footnotes

MIGUEL BABY asked along out of the gate to keep up with the first flight, continued to vie through the turn while closest to the inside, disposed of the other speed when straightened for home, kept to task. CALHOUN STONEWALL lacked early foot, off the inside through the turn, dropped to the rail for the drive and staged a rally for the place, no real threat to the winner. STAR NORTH behind the first flight, five wide into the turn, ranged up to lodge a brief bid while continuing five wide in the turn, flattened out after losing ground to the winner entering the stretch, salvaged the show. SPARTAN forwardly placed, from the start, vied four wide through the turn, weakened in the drive. T. THOMAS off slowly, void of early foot, three wide turn, improved position while not a serious threat. DORVAN vied up front while between rivals for a half, gave way in the drive. SHOMEWHATUWORKKNWIT settled off the pace, lacked a late bid. PHATZO lacked speed, was six wide out of the turn, set down, failed to respond. CAPTAIN RICOCHET soundly bumped at the start, was never close. IZZO with the pace for a half while three wide and between rivals, backed up through the stretch. DUSTIN DUDE remained always back. BOLD BIT N RUN bumped soundly at the break, was finished before a half.
