Z ROCKSTAR pressured the early leader from along the inside, picked up and moved out for room into the far turn causing PRICELESS SHORE to steady which resulted in EXPLAIN to be in tight quarters, went back after that same leader into the far turn, dueled into the lane, gradually edged clear under steady handling. FOLLOWING A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF EXPLAIN AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE INTO THE FAR TURN, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. EXPLAIN tracked the pace while off the inside, in tight entering the far turn, fell back a bit, roused for the drive, finished up willingly to be clearly second best. KID SIDNEY lacked speed, saved ground through the second turn, finished best of the rest. COACH narrowly set the pace off the inside, moved a bit closer to the rail into the far turn, dueled with the winner the next quarter mile and weakened. CORPORATE CHAPEL off the pace, was five wide into the far turn, continued well off the inside through that bend, failed to muster a rally when asked in the drive. PRICELESS SHORE broke out, straightened to stalk the pace off the the inside, shied slightly when the winner moved out entering the far turn, weakened soon after. GAMEDAY NEWS bothered at the start, raced back early, closer four wide the middle half mile, gave way in the drive.
