### Footnotes

ZAPPER BELLE showed the way early, relinquished the advantage onto the backstretch, regained the lead upper stretch, headed late, fought back in game fashion to prove best. PSYCHO CHICK unhurried in the early going, advanced in the second turn, challenged when straightened for home, led late, outkicked. SCAT BABY last to leave, saved ground, moved closer in the second turn, moved out, along for the show while no match for the top two. RUN WILD off the pace, continued to race back into the lane, moved out a bit then came up empty for the drive. SHERRY ANGEL rank while fighting her rider in the first turn, pulled when going to the front onto the backstretch, got clear, gave way readily nearing the furlong marker after being replaced on the lead. MOON DANCING forwardly placed for a half, five wide through the final turn, stopped in the drive.
