GENTLEMEN'S BET came in just after the star, raced forward, advanced to challenge between rivals turning for home, quickly clear, ridden out. TIZ TEE TIME broke out, raced back, traffic, waited into the lane, steered out, finished full of run late. RIGHT TO VOTE came in, bumped LIVONZIN at the start, straightened and showed the way off the inside, clear into the turn, could not last. QUE POSSE bothered at the start, lacked speed, five wide into the lane, staged a mild rally while remaining out in the strip. GHOSTBUSTER lacked speed, four wide through the turn, made little impact in the drive. JAKE MO bumped start, raced within striking distance off the inside, had little left for the drive. LIVONZIN bounced around at the start, raced off the pace while three wide, failed to muster a rally in the drive. OKIE TUFF bothered at the start, raced in mid pack, in a bit tight along the rail in some traffic late in the turn, faded in the drive. LAUNCH LIGHT prompted the pace for three furlongs and stopped.
