Footnotes

DENALI SILVER got clear soon after the start, firmly rated through the turn, remained clear past the furlong marker, enough left to hold the next two safe late under firm handling. CONSERVATIVE VALUE unhurried in the early going, four wide when moving closer in the turn, set down for the drive, gaining late. HARD NOSED forwardly placed, closer turn, chased the winner into the lane, roused, gaining on that foe late while between the top two at the wire. DEVIL'S HAMMOCK off slow, raced back early, came four wide into the lane, managed a modest gain while remaining out in the strip. RUDDYS BUDDY toward the front while racing in some traffic, called on for some run midway on the turn, three wide into the lane, lacked a closing response. LION'S DUB lacked speed, five wide out of the turn when roused, staged a mild rally down the middle of the strip while too late. EISWEIN broke in and slowly, trailed well back while saving ground, displayed some late interest up the rail after the issue had been decided. TOGA'S STORM lacked speed, failed to muster a rally. ILLUSIVE HEART off bit slow, raced wide while outrun. MISTER H chased early, gave way. MUSEUM TOUR bothered slightly at the start, hustled, stopped in the drive. ALI FRAZIER steadily faded.
