HOT NEEDLE behind the leaders off the rail. ranged up three wide turning for home, took over, drew out. **HOWDY DOODY TIME** off the pace in the three path early, bit closer four wide turning for home, no match for the winner in the drive, game for the place. **MADE THE CUT** lacked speed, came six wide when advancing into the stretch, outfinished for the place while remaining out in the strip. **INSOMNIAC** vied up front along the inside, fell back in the turn, moved out, rebid upper stretch, flattened out. **MARKED TEXAN** behind the pace, in some traffic late in the turn, three wide into the stretch, went evenly to the wire. **J B'S STYLISH CAT** void of speed inside, moved out for the drive, found best stride too late. **CASANOVA COWBOY** lacked a late bid. **CLARE'S REPORT** failed to menace. **COREYS STORMIN MAD** six wide through much of the turn, lacked a late kick. **PAJAMIANO** finished early. **HAYDAY'S PAYDAY** duelled off the inside, cleared to the inside turn, stopped in the drive. **JESSE'S GOLD TOO** trailed throughout.
