ARRIVED HOME broke alertly, allowed the pace to go early, moved out, called on for some run into the lane, brushed, closed with good determination to prove narrowly best. GOLD PEG settled off the pace toward the inside, began to rally inside the winner when straightened for home, rider had his whip knocked from his hands a furlong out, brushed, proved game to the end. EARLY EDDIE back off the pace, advanced four wide in the turn, flattened out a bit midstretch, picked it up again late with some late interest. THE STEEL WARRIOR bothered start, raced back early improved toward the inside turn, raced in some traffic entering the lane, picked up another couple of placings through the lane, not a serious threat for the win. SCRIVENER'S ERROR broke in and last, trailed early, five wide late in the turn, did not menace. CHEEP SONGLASSES got clear early, continued to show the way through the turn, clear again with a furlong remaining, fell apart the final furlong. FULMINATOR fell steadily back, off the inside, continued to show little in a dull effort. RISKY RECOVERY moved up to press the pace for four furlongs, stopped in the drive. JUMPINJULESJENKINS was finished early.
