Footnotes

CACHE ME broke out, was straightened to race behind the leader three wide, advanced on the leader, bid nearing the furlong marker, drove well clear. CITY SLEWTIONS broke alertly, dueled up front off the inside, came in slightly entering the turn to tighten DIXIE WARRIOR, inherited a daylight advantage when that one checked up, showed the way into the stretch, raced on equal terms with the winner past the furlong marker, no match for that one to the wire, remained clear for the place. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE TRAINER OF DIXIE WARRIOR AGAINST CITY SLEWTIONS FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE ENTERING THE TURN WAS NOT ALLOWED. GATE ZAPPER void of speed, saved some ground through the turn, angled out for the drive, lodged a belated bid to earn the show. BRIDAL TRAIN raced back, advanced on the outside into the lane, flattened out, outkicked for the show. DANCE IN THE SNOW raced outside in the second flight, lacked a late response in the drive. FIRST QUALITY broke out and slowly, trailed for a half, picked off a couple of tiring rivals. MOVIN EMPRESS in the second group while along the inside, faded. DIXIE WARRIOR broke in good order, checked up in tight quarters entering the turn, quickly fell back, continued to fade drive.
