WAGSON allowed the pace to go early, came four wide into the lane, rallied willingly while well out in the strip to win going away. DEADLY CARD dueled up front toward the inside, no match for the winner the final furlong, narrowly held the place. SCHOENE FRANZEL settled off the pace and the inside, set down upper stretch, managed a late run to be up for the show. ORIGINAL ART broke out, straightened, dueled up front while racing off the inside, caught late for the show while between horses at the wire. YUKONRUN last to leave, raced well back while saving ground, displayed a modest amount of late interest while continuing along the rail. BRIDGE OF ALLAN void of speed, moved out, five wide into the lane, managed to close some ground late. LOUIE THE LIP in the second flight early, faded in the drive, well beaten.
