MAGIC UNION off the pace while racing inside, advanced, took over outside the leader turning for home, clear, enough left to last. GLORYS LAST CHANCE settled off the pace in the two path, continued off the inside, set down for the drive, gaining late. MARY BERNICE bumped at the start, raced unhurried, between rivals into the lane, late run toward the inside. CALL PAT slow to settle, fell far back, made a good gain on the outside and four wide second turn, flattened out in the final furlong. GRIT AND GRACE lacked speed, failed to muster a serious late kick. ELLIE'S THE BOSS chased the early leader, gave way. MEDIUM OF EXCHANGE was never a factor. READY EXPRESS sprinted clear just after the start, garnered a larger advantage before a half, faltered when headed by the winner exiting the final turn. SOUTHERN JEWEL forwardly placed early, steadily faded, finished well back. SOUTHERN DYNAMO off the pace, fell further back, far back.
