LAWYER RON broke middle of pack, slow to settle inside, moved out late in the first turn, ranged up into a striking position into the far turn under confident handling, challenged five wide turning for home, suddenly clear, kept to task, sharp. RED RAYMOND void of early foot, steadied onto backstretch, circled the field with a nice move six wide turning for home, proved no match for the winner in the drive, determined for the place. STEPPENWOLFER also back early, advanced five wide in the second turn into contention, could do little with winner as well, outfinished for the place. WELL SAID in the second flight while off the inside, asked and moved a bit closer in traffic in the second turn, failed to sustain that advance and was going evenly at the end. FILM FORTUNE off slow, trailed early, raced toward the inside turning for home, switched to the far outside, improved position midtrack. NOB HILL DEELITE settled off the pace and off the inside, traffic, brief wait four wide into the lane, lacked a significant late response when clear in the drive. PRIVATE VOW hard held early, continued under stout restraint into the far turn, split foes into the stretch, came up empty. MUSIC SCHOOL forwardly placed, vied four wide into the far turn, gave way in the drive. KIP DEVILLE pressed early, vied the middle half, gave way in the drive. TRAVELIN LEROY a pace factor inside, stopped.
