KEYSTONE KID with the first flight early, moved back to the fore while three wide turning for home, long drive, proved narrowly best under firm handling. BRUSHWITHTHEDEVIL forwardly placed, came four wide and outside the winner when making a bid turning for home, failed to match that one late, held sway for the place. PERFECTLY GOLDEN narrowly set the pace closest to the inside, dueled into the far turn, not enough in the late going. KIAMICHI pressed weakening. ROSSFERRY settled in off the pace, nothing for the drive in a weak effort. HALLOWED GROUND was never involved. PINE SIREN finished early, well beaten.
