SAINT'S RELIC behind the first group, continued to stalk the pace four wide through the turn, moved to challenge turning for home, drew clear under pressure. SHORTY SMALL brushed, fell back after the start in lacking speed, angled out to be five wide out of the turn, rallied for the place, no threat to the winner. INTOTHEWILD brushed start, vied up front along the inside, disposed of the other speed entering the stretch, weakened, lasted for the show. DRINKS TO GO raced back, came six wide out of the bend, staged a mild rally to improve position a bit. HOLD'EM OR FOLD'EM vied up front for four furlongs between foes and weakened. ZOOMING WHITE STAR unhurried, saved ground turn, squeezed through rail, had little for the drive. CECILSLUCKYMISTAKE forwardly placed for a half outside, retreated in the drive. COSTA DE ORO sluggish to start, showed little.
