**Footnotes**

HEDGE YOUR RISK broke sharp, set all the pace just off the inside, floated rivals out a bit turning for home, drifted out slightly upper stretch, clear, held late. A CLAIM OF FOUL BY THE RIDER OF HARVARD AGAINST THE WINNER FOR ALLEGED INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH WAS NOT ALLOWED. PANDERING bothered slightly at the start, dropped to the inside behind the leaders in the turn, finished willingly to be getting to the winner late while inside that one. GENE THE JET also bothered slightly at the start, vied up front three wide, little left for the top two late, salvaged the show. HARVARD broke out to tight up outer foes, quickly straightened to vie between rivals, was tiring when steered in then back out stretch, little left late. ZIPPITY DUBAI broke out, brushed, settled off the pace and the inside, improved position a bit in the drive while never dangerous. JENNY'S TOUCH went

evenly paced throughout in the three path. WAKARUSA in tight at the start, lacked a response in the drive. SIR SHERMAN took up at the start, raced back, came five wide out of the turn, failed to muster a rally. BIG KENNY broke in, brushed, failed to menace. TACTICAL MAN fell back after the start, never a threat. DEVIL'S RAGE broke slow, always outrun. DRY RIDGE broke in, raced well back, six wide out of the turn, remained outrun.
