Footnotes

CLEAN HIT with the pace from the outside shook off the other speed while three wide into the lane, increased advantage under steady handling. ADGER lacked speed, asked for some run three wide turning for home, angled in slightly, got up for the place in the late going. RATIFY in the second flight, angled out to be four wide turning for home, closest to the winner a furlong out, nipped late for the place. SAUCY LUCK in the second group and outside, came five wide into the lane, lacked the necessary late response. LEOPOLD BLOOM six wide late in the turn, improved only slightly. GOLDEN AGE lacked early foot, improved position while never a threat. CANADIAN PACIFIC vied up front early closest to the inside, retreated. SECRET SPICE was never a threat. CRESRAN vied up front while three wide stopped in the drive. MILLENNIUM KNIGHT last away, was finished early.
