EVE GISELLE pressured the early leader off the rail, took over turning for home, came out under a left handed stick mid stretch to bother a foe who was beginning to tire, drew clear, kept to task. WILD HOPE lacked speed while toward the inside, moved out four wide for the drive, finished up willingly to earn the place. RIPE TOMATO off a bit slow, raced back, moved out to be widest for the drive, rallied down the middle of the track and was going well at the end. GLOWING REPORT forwardly placed while four wide through the turn, closest to the winner a furlong out, was beginning to tire when that rival came out, bothered, continued to weaken. BELL'S SHOES in the three path and off the pace, bothered slightly midstretch, lacked a meaningful bid when in position to strike the final furlong. SAKAKAWEA broke on top, set the pace inside, gave way when headed entering the stretch. RIGAMARO in tight at the start, was never a threat. GO MILAN GO behind the pace toward the inside, steadied inside of traffic turn, did not recover. BIKINI BELLA broke a bit to the outside, forwardly placed, backed up in the drive.
