MARGIE MARIE slight bump start, prompted the early pace from the outside, took over in the turn, clear when straightened for home, driving. TIDE RUNNER bumped start, lacked early foot, rallied toward the inside, moved out, continued willingly to the end. PRIMETIME PRINCESS broke on top, set the early pace, weakened a bit in the drive, salvaged the show. TRIPLE IT forwardly placed, had little left for the drive. SUPERFLY GIRL came up empty in the drive. DANCING DUDETE void of early foot, passed tiring foes. GOOD MORNING NELL three wide in the turn, failed to rally. MS MAGDLEAN was never involved. VICTORIOUS HALO failed to menace. COUSIN SALLY far back.
