JUSTIN PHILLIP unhurried in the early going, four wide when beginning to advance exiting the turn, engaged the leader nearing the furlong marker, won going away under token encouragement. BET SEATTLE forwardly placed, three wide bid turning for home, gained the advantage into the stretch, proved no match for the winner, remained clear for the place. GRAND SENSATION last away, raced back early, staged a modest rally on the outside to finish best of the others. HUMBLE SMARTY pressed the issue early off the inside, moved up to vie briefly between rivals out of the turn, had little left the final furlong. CREDIT REPORT broke alertly, showed the way early along the inside, gave way in the drive. BEWARE THE DEVIL finished in the early going, trailed home.
