Footnotes

JAKE MO with the pace from the start, dueled through the turn, kicked strongly clear in the drive, intermittent handling past the furlong marker, wrapped up late to win ridden out. FREDERICO off the early pace, raced between rivals through the turn, came out, brushed, bumped upper stretch, no match for winner. HELISKIER vied up front in the early going, dueled outside the winner through the turn, proved no match for that one in the drive, caught late for the place. J J GARBAR shuffled back in some traffic with a half to run, encountered traffic again exiting the turn, brushed foe midstretch, improved late. HEAVEN'S RUNWAY within striking distance outside, brushed with the runner up upper stretch, steadied when that one came out with a furlong remaining, continued to weaken. DOC ALMON off a step slow, raced back, five wide into the lane when moving a bit slow, lacked a late kick. PLATITUDE prompted the early pace along the inside, steadied when in a bit tight late in the turn, brushed a furlong out, no late bid. OFFICER ALEX was always outrun. KING CORAL lacked speed, came five wide out of the turn when back, lacked a late response when called on soon after.
