Footnotes

HUMBLE MADELINE lacked speed, circled six wide into contention late in the turn, came in slightly into the stretch, drove clear. CAT'S THEME off the pace, in a bit tight when five wide turning into the stretch, second best. GOLDRUSH LADY bobbled at the start, moved up to show the way into the turn while off the inside, best of the speed, weakened, best of the rest. MARY ANN'SMOMENT sluggish early, saved ground while well off the pace early in the turn, angled out for the drive, improved a bit. ONEOFTHEGIRLS forwardly placed, shuffled back in the turn, lacked clear room nearing the furlong marker, finished up evenly. STEPHE GIRL forwardly placed and five wide turning for home, was weakening when pinched back. AMIDST STORM with the pace for a half three wide, faltered. HAWLEY LAKE vied up front along the inside, in a bit tight midway on the turn, gave way in the drive. LADY BELLE in the second flight in the turn, gave way in traffic.
