Footnotes

SOONER HUMOR asked a bit along the inside to maintain position into the first turn, continued to vie up the backstretch, showed the way into the far turn, shook clear into the stretch, drifted out, enough left to last. CONWAY rated behind the first flight, advanced three wide early second turn, dropped inside, turning for home, good gain late. CONCERNED OKIE off a step slow, trailed for five furlongs, belated rally for the show, no real threat to the top two. PULGARCITO lacked speed, improved position in the second turn, flattened out in the drive, outkicked for the show. SILENT MONEY vied four wide when with the leaders through the first turn, chased the winner into the far turn, could not keep up with that one, weakened late. RESCIND THE TRADE set or forced the pace while between rivals early, gave way after a half. MISTER THAYER vied up front while three wide, gave way in the far turn. VOLTURI five wide when pressing the early pace, stopped, finished far back.
