BID A MOON closest to the leader while off the inside, went after that rival into the turn, put a head in front late in the bend, quickly clear, driving. ILLEGALLY BLONDE lacked speed for a half, shifted to the far outside when straightened for home, finished willingly to be in time for the place, no threat to the winner. PERENNIAL SONG back off the pace, saved ground through the turn, steered out turning for home, not enough for the place. COOL IT BOYS last to leave, moved out, came five wide into the lane, improved a bit while also lacking enough of a punch to annex the place. BELLAMY'S FIRE in the second flight while off the inside, came up empty in the drive to finish up evenly. RUNGE fell far back, wide into lane, picked off a couple of tiring rivals while never a serious threat. FRANNIE G in the second group inside, tired in the drive. BROOKS BEACH broke very alertly, quickly got clear, gave way when headed midway on the turn.
