**Footnotes**

SON OF A GENERAL in a bit tight at the start, fell back, raced in the two path early, dropped to the inside turning for home, roused, in time up rail. SPEIGHTER MAN unhurried while racing outside, moved closer four wide in the second turn, challenged when straightened for home, gained the advantage well out in the strip, outkicked to the wire while drifting in slightly. OMNISCIENT within striking distance, raced in some traffic into the lane, up for the show. DEVIL AND A HALF took over toward the inside before a half, showed the way through the second turn, weakened in the drive. TRUETAP last away, trailed, five wide into the lane, improved position while well out in the strip. ON THE LOOSE AGAIN lacked speed, four wide into the lane, improved position. WINGS OF WAR set the early pace off the inside, relinquished the advantage before a half, pressed the leader into the lane, weakened. CHANNELING fell back early. LIMEHOUSE BLUES rank into the first turn, was always outrun. SPECIAL KID forward for a half, stopped.
