BREWING broke alertly, soon got clear, given a bit a breather in the turn, stayed well clear through the lane while being kept to task. BIG SUGAR SODA completely lacking in early foot well out in the strip, swung out to be five wide exiting the turn, finished full of run to annex the place, too late for the winner. CONDO CLOSING also well off the early pace, four wide through the turn, staged a mild rally to be along for the show. GUNS LOADED went evenly paced while three wide turn, two path in the drive, lacked a serious kick. SPEIGHTSONG closest to the leader through the turn, had little left for the final furlong. KENDALL'S BOY in tight, steadied at the start, raced back, made little impact. DUNKIN BEND in between foes into the turn, bothered slightly when MISTER POLLARD checked up, faded. MISTER POLLARD in the second flight inside, appeared to take a bad step into the turn, checked up, fell back.
