PHILADELPHIA BLUES off bit slow, rallied well out in the strip, too late midtrack. TRICKSKI prompted the pace after breaking alertly, lacked a winning response. CAMETOPLAY forwardly placed, came on the inside late in the turn, also came up empty. CIELO CORAZON lacked a late rally. DISENFRANCHISED took up in traffic entering the turn, fell back, evenly in the drive. NEVER BEEN KISSED never close. ZIG'S QUIET LADY finished early.
