DENOUEMENT brushed at the start, raced forwardly and inside, continued to track the leader, brief wait turning for home, got through, brushed, edged clear under firm handling. ALEJANDRO B showed the way off the inside, continued to set the pace up the backstretch in hand, responded when challenged turning for home, gave ground grudgingly to the winner, came back for the place. DOC HEATH within striking distance three wide, continued forwardly the middle half, challenged outside the winner turning for home, vied past the furlong marker then hung. AIRLINER void of early foot, trailed for a half, displayed a modest amount of late interest to improve position up the inside, never a serious threat. TRUE TATOO four wide in the first turn, raced forwardly, 3w bid and between foes into lane, was beginning to tire when brushed up the winner upper stretch, continued to tire. LEXINGTON PARK forwardly placed for a half, faded. MATCHLESS last away, failed to rally. BARCELONA KID had nothing for the drive. ACE'S LIMIT finished after a half, fell far back, distanced.
