Footnotes

INCOGNITO BANDITO vied early closest to the inside, vied onto the backstretch, clear in the far turn while remaining in hand and on the rail, drew off, ridden out. BROTHER DAY off the early pace, also saved ground, up for the place up the rail while not a threat to the winner. SGT BILKO fell back off the pace, moved toward the inside, failed to menace. WILD SLEW vied up front while between rivals, steadily faded. SUNSHINE WARRIOR last away, trailed early while racing in the two path, displayed a modest amount of late interest while out in the strip after the issue had been decided. CARISTO never a threat while racing off the inside. GLASS DARKLY broke out, raced forward and well off the inside, faded. DOCTOR PETER vied up front off the inside, duelled through most of the run up the backstretch, proved no match for the winner the final three furlongs, caught late by the runner up outside that rival.
