COZY SQUALL off slow, unhurried for five furlongs, began a steady gain four wide into the far turn, reached the leader turning for home, wore that foe down under steady handling. CRAFTY MEME away well, quick duel closest to the inside, gave ground stubbornly in a good effort. DOLCE DIVA within striking distance second turn toward the inside, moved out, lacked a winning late kick. SIMPLESUBSTITUTION lacked speed, asked second turn, evenly drive. TAYLOR TOT chased early, quick duel backstretch, gave way in the second turn. SARATOGA FLASH forwardly placed, had little left for the drive. DRIVING THE ALLEY never close. SWISS SPLASH stopped after five furlongs, stopped.
