MAJOR PRINCE roughed at the start, recovered and showed the way into the first turn, allowed a foe to show the way in the run up the backstretch, took back over far turn when that foe gave way, increased advantage to the wire under steady handling. SUN BEAR roughed at the start, settled off the pace, could do little with the winner in the drive, held sway for the place. INTHENICKOFTIME in tight at the start, raced back off the pace, staged a mild rally to finish up best of the rest while off the inside. WOLFCAMP no trouble, made little impact. PULPIT'S SECRET wiped out start, raced well back, improved a bit while not a serious threat. DAKOTA DIGGER ducked out at the start to impede several rivals, raced extremely rank along the inside early while attempting to rate, bit closer into the far turn, began to give way soon after. FOLLOWING A STEWARDS' INQUIRY REGARDING THE START, THE RESULT WAS ALLOWED TO STAND. NIGHT HUNT broke in, took over onto the backstretch, stopped badly, eased.
