### Footnotes

PUKA SHELL stalked the pace outside, moved up to challenge under confident handling late in the turn, gained the advantage with a quarter remaining, drew out steadily in the late while being kept to task. FAVORABLE VERDICT broke alertly, set the pace for almost a half, headed for the place a furlong out, came back in game fashion to earn that position. COURTNMOLLYANNE within striking distance, moved closer inside the winner toward the front late in the turn, failed to sustain that effort the final furlong, outfinished for the place. JOHNNYESREVENGE off the pace, came three wide and under pressure into the lane, improved. SPRING CHOIR last away, lacked speed, came five wide out of the turn, improved a bit with a mild rally out in the strip. KIPABLE devoid of early foot, picked off some tiring foes after the issue had been decided. LINDA GOT EVEN dropped inside the opening quarter, failed to threaten. DRINK AND A WINK pressured the runner up early, faded. CASA LIMA tired four wide. FRIENDLY FACE remained back. LILLY'S RISK was finished early.
