BIG CAL broke on top, showed the way inside, shrugged off the other speed when straightened for home, drew well clear, kept to task. GENTLEMANSAPPROVAL away in good order, pressured the winner from the outside for a half, could not keep up in the drive, remained comfortably clear for the pace. EDPLICIT forwardly placed off the inside, set down for the drive, had little for the top two, salvaged the place. DICTUM lacked speed along the inside, angled out sharply to be five wide into the lane, staged a mild rally while well out in the strip. KISSIN CHILD off the pace, raced four wide through the turn, lacked a significant late response. READY AND WILD forwardly placed, gradually faded. FROGGYVILLE lacked speed, floated out six wide into the lane, made little impact down the lane. WINNING WILDCAT last to leave, trailed for a half, slight bother in some traffic turning for home, remained back. STORM HALF settled in the middle of the pack, tired in the drive. LEONIDES staged a steady retreat.
