Footnotes

WAIMEA CANYON outrun in the early going while three wide through the first turn, continued well off the pace backstretch, began to move while four wide into the far turn, came five wide when rallying smartly into the stretch, finished full of run to win going away. JACK KNIFE lacked early foot, made a steady gain into contention while four wide up the backstretch, challenged a furlong out, proved no match for the winner late, clearly second best. WOO PIG SOOIE dueled early while off the inside, got clear before a half, continued to show the way into the stretch, could not contain the top two, lasted for the show. ANARCHY evenly paced throughout in lacking a late kick. TRUST MORE lacked speed, came four wide into the lane, managed little in the way of any late gain. KID YOU NOT trailed early, continued back, passed some tiring rivals while not a serious threat. BIG THOMPSON dueled up front closest to the inside, weakened. DUCA stalked the pace while three wide, closer far turn, brief bid, gave way just as readily when the real running started at the head of the lane. KATE'S FOREST tired while five wide. HIT IT HARD settled off the pace and the inside, gave way after a half.
