Footnotes

MIAMI GHOST close from the start, vied up front along the inside turn, put a head in front nearing the furlong grounds, drew strongly clear. A CREDIBLE THREAT showed the way early, garnered a slightly larger advantage in the turn, was no match for the winner late, lugged in a bit, held the place. CAJUN CAVEMAN off the early pace, four wide when with the second flight through the turn, roused, finished up willingly while remaining out in the strip to gain the nod for the show. STELLAR EXPLOSION lacked speed, raced five wide through the turn, missed the show while widest in the drive. GONE COWBOY lacked speed, off the inside, improved position while never really dangerous. THE DEVIL'S IMAGE pressured the pace for a half while between foes, had little left for the drive. BALUARTE dwelt at the start to spot the field several lengths, continued to trail early, passed tiring rivals. CRESCENT CITY HERO within striking distance, failed to respond when asked in the drive. FOR THE HORDE settled off the early pace and also had nothing for the drive. DENALI SURPRISE showed little. BUNKHOUSE broke through the gate prior to the start, was never close.
