OFFICER ALEX cleared to the inside before a quarter, rated through the turn when showing the way, continued in front and on the rail stretch, kept to task. BOSS MAN ROCKET pushed in, bumped foe start, raced forward, prompted the winner through the turn, could do little with that rival in the drive, remained clear for the place. MANEWAL off slowly, raced back, four wide when advancing in the turn, slowly getting to the runner up late. EGYPTIAN WARRIOR boxed in along the inside when within striking distance, failed to respond when asked in the drive. DIPSY DREW broke to the inside setting off a chain reaction of interference, raced forwardly and three wide, lacked a late kick. SMOKEY DEPUTY pushed in at the start, also failed to muster a rally. SUGAR BUSINESS soundly bumped at the start, steadied early along the inside, continued under stout restraint into the turn, steadily fell back.
