MY IRISH GIRL stalked the pace toward the inside, in some traffic turning for home, challenged inside the furlong marker, edged clear under pressure. MISS ATLANTIC broke on top, soon got clear, set the pace, no match for the winner late, remained well clear for the place. IRON BUTTERFLY settled off the pace and the inside, moved out a bit for the drive, best of the rest. BIT OF A LADY devoid of early foot, displayed a mild amount of late interest up the rail. PRINCESS BIANCONI raced within striking distance, brushed three sixteenths out, lacked a closing kick. PRETTY IN MINK last to leave, failed to menace. MEIN FRAULEIN remained back, outrun. BANK DEPOSIT chased the runner up, brushed when tiring upper stretch, continued to back up.
