FORGOTTEN KNOT slight bother start, prompted the leader off the inside, challenged that rival into the far turn, dueled into the lane, roused, proved best while fully extended. GENTLE TAP in the second flight three wide first turn, second flight up the backstretch, four wide in the second turn, could not get to the winner in the drive, clear for the place. MAJOR DUOMO broke out, got clear early, set the pace, held the show. SHERTZER off the pace, moved closer in the far turn inside, failed to sustain that advance through the lane despite pressure. HAPTOWN four wide in the first turn, ranged up five wide into the second turn, wide into the lane, hung in the drive. CHRISTMAS PUNCH last away, closer six wide into the far turn, faded through the lane. STATEHOOD bothered a bit at the start, raced toward the front while under restraint first turn, continued to race within striking distance, gave way in the drive. CONWAY broke in, was through early.
