REASON TO TALK closest to the early leader, ranged up outside that rival and dueled through the second turn, shook clear just outside the furlong marker, held sway late. BONITA ROSE outrun early, moved closer and chased the two leaders through the turn, came on the outside late, slowly closing the late gap. APPY EVERAFTER staged a mild rally from well back to finish best of the rest. PHILANTHA broke slowly, raced far back for six furlongs, found her best stride too late. IDADIDIT broke on stop, set a clear early pace, dueled third quarter closest to the inside, gave way in the drive. YALTA lacked speed, showed little in a dull effort. MEADOW MISS forwardly placed for a half, faded. LEAP FOR JOY four wide first turn, never menaced. WALKIN SEXY carried wide in the first turn, gave way after three quarters.
