BURNIN ANA LOOTIN prompted the pace off the inside, challenged, gained the advantage into the stretch, came in, brushed rival nearing the furlong marker, proved best under firm handling. EDILE'S SPIRIT outrun for a half while saving ground, angled out late in the turn, traffic past the furlong marker, willingly for the place late when clear. R NANEE back early, set down four wide exiting the turn, brushed deep stretch, some late gain. KRYBABY K T staged a mild advance on the outside in the turn, brushed deep stretch, was going evenly at the wire. ROSE GLITTER sprinted clear soon after the start, set the pace, brushed midstretch, faltered. ETTA KAY BLACKHAWK trailed for a half, found best stride too late. MAZURKA tired from early efforts while racing inside. SOLAR CAM was outrun while wide. SPEAKINGROCK showed brief speed, stopped.
