TRIPLE MANDATE broke sharp, cleared into the turn toward the inside, drew off stretch, driving. A BIT TOUCHY bumped at the start, saved ground through the turn, got through turning for home, proved no match for the winner. FERVENT HOPE raced off the inside, finished best of the rest. PASSMNALEXUS four wide late in the turn, managed little in the way of a rally. HOT PISTOL bumped at the start, not a menace. ETHICS dueled up front briefly inside the winner, gave way. WHY GO WEST was never involved.
