Footnotes

SHARP WON behind the pace, steered out for room entering the stretch, bid, quickly clear. SCRIVENER'S ERROR forwardly placed and outside, four wide when putting a head in front entering the turn, narrowly showed the way into the stretch, no match for the winner, brushed, all out to narrowly hold the place. HIGHFLYERTOTHELINE set or forced the pace while between foes, continued to vie into the stretch, brushed, rail trip stretch, missed the place. MANHATTAN MAN forwardly placed while four wide and between foes into the turn, steadied slightly, came six wide into the stretch, displayed a modest amount of late interest. BULLZABOY void of speed, roused while six wide out of the turn, improved position while no real threat. MAIN MANN LEE with the early leaders, steadied slightly in tight quarters early in the turn, fell back. ONE SUAVE CAT moved well out in the strip, made little impact. SILLY GOLD never close. W W HEIR MAIL vied up front closest to the inside, shuffled back into the turn, continued to fade.
