Footnotes

LASTING IMPACT back off the early pace, began a steady advance after a quarter, took over turning for home, drove strongly clear. INDIAN RED settled off the pace, waited briefly behind a wall of horses when moving closer late in the final turn, steered out, rallied to be clear for the place. LANGFURS LIGHTNING within striking distance off the inside, lacked a winning response in the drive. CLEVER ROYAL off a bit slow, saved ground to no avail. TAP THE ADMIRAL forwardly placed well off the inside, advanced on the leader and gained a brief advantage midway on the second turn, faltered in the drive. ALL STAR BELL hesitated start, trailed early, bothered, carried out late first turn, improved position while never a serious threat. GEEZE WALLY bothered, carried wide first turn when off the pace, failed to rally. IONIC SILVER broke on top, set the pace, gave way when headed in the second turn. CHALYBEATE SPRINGS got out, rank, steadied in the first turn, fell back, eventually distanced after losing contact with the field.
