KNOCK EM FLAT broke with the field, asked just a bit to maintain inside position early, took command into the first turn toward the inside, rated kindly in the run up the backstretch, increased advantage through the lane while being kept to task in a sharp effort. HARBOR BOUND forwardly placed, chased the winner into the lane, no match, clearly second best. I'MBETTERTHANGOOD within striking distance three wide, continued to maintain contact with the winner second turn, came up empty for the drive. JOYFUL MOMENTS five wide when back off the pace in the first turn, moved slightly closer the third quarter, flattened out to finish up evenly. IDENTITY CRISIS bumped at the start, void of early foot, improved position while not a serious threat. STREET PRANCER closest to the winner, gave way late in the second turn. LIFE AT MIDNIGHT back off the pace, lacked a late bid when called on in the drive. NO DISHONOR in tight, bothered at the start, in the second flight early, weakened. SATURDAY SENSATION bumped at the start, raced back off the pace, showed little. CANADIAN WINNER fractious in the gate, steadied just after the start, trailed throughout to be always outrun.
