ADRIANNE G broke sharp, early pace, breather into the turn, quickly shook clear when straightened for home, roused, not threatened late. MIDNIGHT ECLIPSE hesitated at the start, far back, moved to the far outside for the drive, finished full of run late to be in time for the place. SIX TONSAFUN in the second flight outside, moved closer while five wide late in the turn, fanned five wide into the lane, caught late for the place. SPRINGSTEEN ROAD bumped at the start, quickly recovered to race forwardly and three wide, lacked a late punch in the drive. FOREVER SINCE bumped at the start, saved ground through the turn, improved a bit, no real threat. DASH TO THE FLASH forwardly placed for a half, came up empty for the drive. AVICII off the pace and the inside, four wide, roused into the lane, failed to rally. SILVER VALLEY pressured the winner from the outside for a half, gave way in the drive. GOLDEN TIAGO four wide trip, remained always back.
